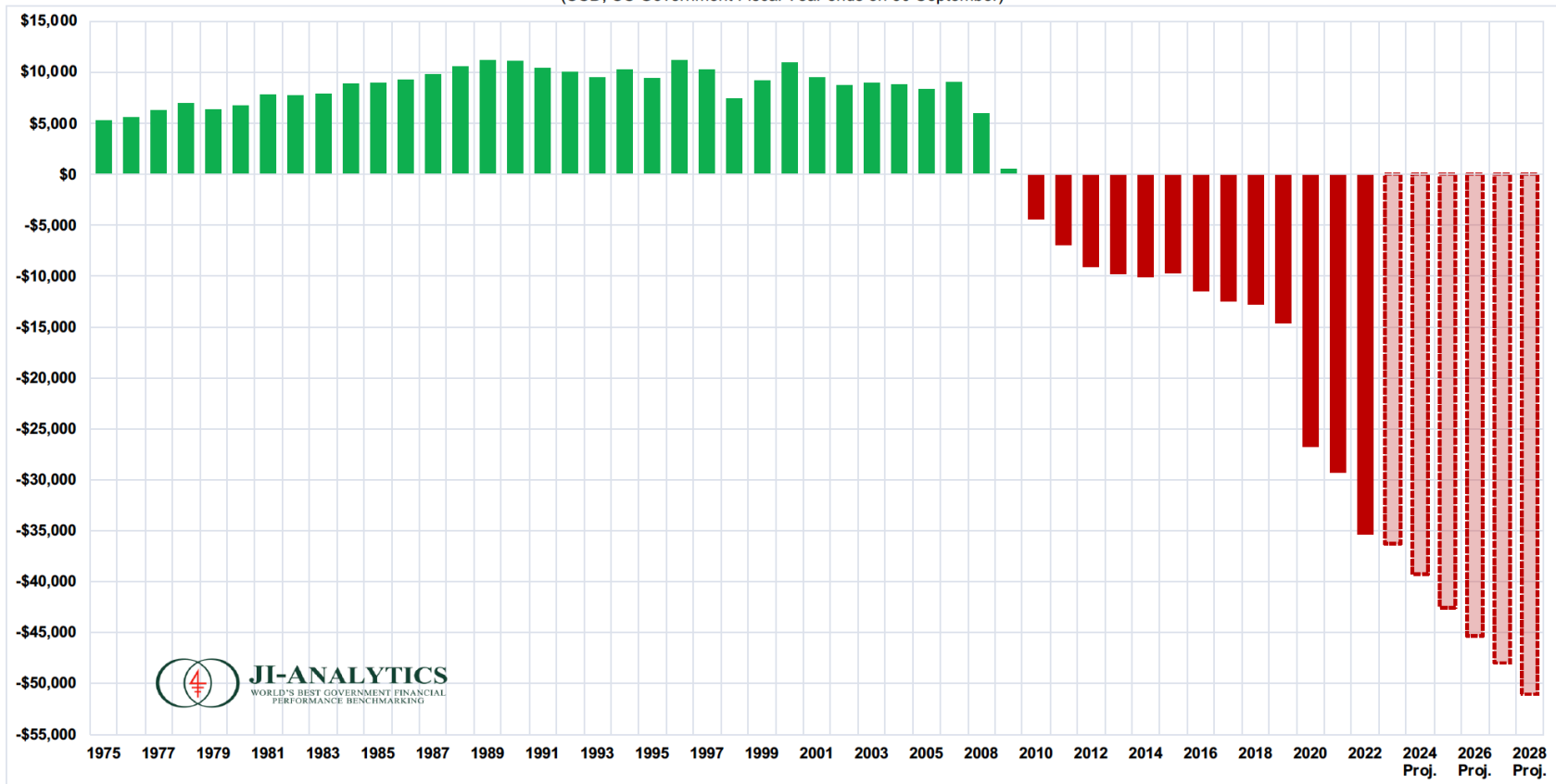


Book Title: **America in 2040: Still A Superpower? A Pathway to Success**

In the 2024 update, the U.S. government Citizens' Wealth numbers graph for 1975 to projected 2028 is included on page 265. In addition, the Citizens' Wealth numbers graph for 2000 to 2019 is on page 216. As David Walker notes: "While we all know that correlation is not necessarily causation, it is interesting to note that federal debt/GDP and the Citizens Wealth Index started to get much worse after I left as Comptroller General of the United States in March 2008."
